Seems the rocker has inspired the men's fashion designer to create a fine of clothing that Crow will wear on her next tour, which kicks off Aug. 15 at Jones Beach in New York.

"Tommy will design clothes, that reflect Sheryl's style and music," says Courtney Moss, Hilfiger's spokeswoman. "He's inspired by her, and there's a definite sense of mutual admiration."

Copies of the rock 'n'roll rags will be available in Hilfiger's Beverly Hills emporium in November; no word yet on styles or prices. Hilfiger, best known for his men's sportswear, began designing women's clothing last fall.

Hilfiger also is a sponsor of Crow's tour, a portion of the proceeds will benefit the Evelyn Lauder Breast Cancer research Fund.
